

**Old** building


Dim and enclosed spaces with no windows







How can the school provide better spaces for **dining**?

Serve food that is healthier and of better quality

Increase the number of seats at existing dining areas

More spaces serving wider variety of food

Decrease proximity between classrooms and dining spaces
